Upholstered Noticeboard Workshop

Creative upholstery that builds focus, confidence and shared intention.

A hands-on upholstery workshop where each participant designs and makes their own fully upholstered noticeboard. Using a choice of fabrics and materials, the finished piece becomes a practical tool for displaying goals, ideas, photos or reminders, continuing to support focus and motivation long after the day.

Format

- 3 hours guided, inclusive upholstery workshop
- Choice of sustainable fabrics and materials to personalise each design
- Tool-based and fully supported
- No prior experience needed

Investment

- £1,800 for a group of 12
- £150 per additional participant. Suitable for groups of up to 16.





Small Leather Goods Workshop

Practical leathercraft with multiple personalised keepsakes to take away.

A guided leathercraft workshop where participants create a selection of small leather items, such as keyrings, card holders or pencil cases. Working with a range of vegetable-tanned and recycled leathers, each person leaves with a set of handcrafted pieces that are both useful and unique.

Format

- 3 hour guided leathercraft workshop
- Choice of small leather projects
- Multiple items completed

Investment

- £1,500 for a group of 12
- £125 per extra participant. Suitable for groups of up to 16.





Leather Belt Workshop

A skill-building leathercraft experience resulting in a timeless, wearable item.

A guided leathercraft workshop where participants measure, cut, punch and finish their own leather belt, choosing from a wide range of vegetable-tanned leather colours and hardware. The experience is practical, grounding and deeply satisfying.

Format

- 3 hour guided leathercraft workshop learning belt-making techniques
- Design and make a full-length leather belt, choosing leather colour and buckle style
- Tool-based, fully supported and inclusive — no prior experience needed

Investment

- £1,500 for a group of 12
- £125 per extra participant. Suitable for groups of up to 16.





Lino Printing Workshop

Calm, accessible printmaking that builds creative confidence with practical keepsakes.

A hands-on lino printing workshop where participants design and carve their own block before printing onto a reusable cotton tote bag, with a choice of printed cards or a notebook cover. The process is inclusive, immersive and confidence-building.

Format

- 3 hour guided lino printing workshop: design, carve and print your own lino block. Print onto a reusable cotton tote bag, plus a choice of 10 A6 cards with envelopes or a printed notebook cover
- Sustainable papers, fabric bags, inks and materials, fully supported with no experience needed

Investment

- £1,500 for a group of 12
- £125 per extra participant. Suitable for groups of up to 16.





Christmas Alcohol Ink Bauble Workshop

A festive, creative experience with a joyful seasonal takeaway.

A relaxed alcohol ink workshop where participants design and decorate a set of glass baubles, experimenting with colour, pattern and finish. Each bauble is completely unique, creating a playful, festive experience with a beautiful decorative result.

Format

- 2 hour guided alcohol ink workshop
- A set of 6 glass baubles created per person
- Festive, relaxed and inclusive

Investment

- £1,020 for a group of 12
- £85 per additional participant. Suitable for groups of up to 20.
